General Summary:

2. Cleans equipment used, including utensils, dishes, mixers, and machines. Performs general kitchen.
3. Performs miscellaneous food service duties as assigned, including but not limited to acting as a cashier or breakfast service, putting machines together, counting money, putting away supplies, securing food in containers for shipment to other school kitchens, cleaning.
4. Serves prepared food to students.
5. Able to react to change productively and handle other essential tasks as assigned.

1. Education Level: High School Diploma or equivalent.
2. Certification or Licensure: Douglas County Food Handler's Certification (required within 30 days of hire)
3. Experience desired: Previous food service experience preferred
4. Other requirements:

 - * Ability and willingness to follow instructions, work in all areas of food service and maintain a positive attitude toward the food service program.
